TUTION AND REGISTRATION FEE SCHEDULE

REGISTRATION FEE - NON-REFUNDABLE - \$50.00 per student

Each student is charged a non-refundable Registration Fee at the time of Registration.

HOURS OF OPERATION:

Monday through Friday, 8:45 - 11:30 am.

As enrolment grows an afternoon program will be offered from 12:30 - 3:00pm.

TUITION FEES:

Please note that these are 2016/2017 fees

Tuition Fees are reviewed and set at the end of May for the next school year. Therefore, there may be a slight increase in the fees for the 2017/2018 year

5 day program: \$360 per month (\$3,600.00 per year)

4 day program: \$288 per month (\$2,880.00 per year)

3 day program: \$216 per month (\$2,160.00 per year)

2 day program: \$144 per month (\$1,440.00 per year)

****Daily snacks will be provided for all programs****

METHOD OF PAYMENT FOR TUITION:

Tuition may be paid in one lump sum, semi-annually or monthly.

However, post-dated cheques must be dated the first of each month.

September tuition is due at time of acceptance and is Non-Refundable.

PARENT PARTICIPATION:

There is an invitation and expectation for parents to be actively involved in the Preschool program by assisting with classroom activities, special events and field trips.

EMERGENCY PREPARATION FEE: \$25.00 for Emergency Comfort Pack provided by the school in case of an earthquake or other emergency situations.

Important Note: There will be a charge of \$20.00 for each NSF Cheque.

ADMISSION POLICY

Admission to St. Patrick's Preschool program is separate from our Kindergarten – Grade 7 program.

3 and 4 year old children are eligible for preschool enrolment if they are at least 3 years of age on December 31st, 2017. Admission to preschool is based on our established preschool admission priority policy.

In the event that applications qualify students in every way possible but enrolment does not permit us to accept every qualified student, we will consider the date of application to be the determining criteria.

If parents request, the school will maintain a waiting list for eligible students; and parents will be contacted as enrolment permits.

ADMISSION PRIORITIES FOR ST. PATRICK'S PRESCHOOL

For the purposes of this policy, "practicing Catholics" shall mean those individuals who are registered in a parish and attend Sunday Mass regularly, "active in a parish" shall mean those who support the parish by using envelopes (no minimum amount specified) and participate in the work activities required of them.

1. Children presently enrolled in the preschool if they and their families meet the expectations of St. Patrick's Preschool.
2. Siblings of children already in the Preschool or K – 7 program, whose families are practicing Catholics active in the parish.
3. Children whose families are practicing Catholics active in the parish.
4. Siblings of children already in the Preschool or K – 7 program, whose families are practicing Catholics active in other parishes.
5. Children whose families are practicing Catholics coming into the parish.
6. Children whose families are practicing Catholics active in other parishes.
7. Children whose families are either not practicing Catholics or not active in their parishes.
8. Non-Catholics.
