## **GYM RULES:**

- ❖ PRACTICE TIME IN THE GYM IS ONLY OPEN TO PLAYERS ON THE TEAMS SCHEDULED AT THAT TIME. SIBLINGS ARE PERMITTED TO SIT QUIETLY ON THE SIDE. IF COACHES FIND THEY ARE HAVING TO DISCIPLINE SIBLINGS, THEY WILL NO LONGER BE ALLOWED TO ATTEND.
- ❖ GAMES & TOURNAMENTS ARE OPEN TO ANYONE WHO WISHES TO WATCH. AN ADULT MUST ACCOMPANY ANY STUDENTS WHO ARE AT THE GAMES AS SPECTATORS.
- ❖ THE BATHROOMS IN THE GYM ARE NOT OPEN TO STUDENTS BEFORE OR AFTER SCHOOL. THEY ARE ONLY OPEN TO MEMBERS OF THE TEAM SCHEDULED TO BE IN THE GYM.
- ❖ BASKETBALLS, VOLLEYBALLS AND ANY OTHER EQUIPMENT MAY NOT BE TAKEN OUTSIDE OF THE GYM. IF A STUDENT TAKES SOMETHING OUTSIDE OF THE GYM THEY WILL BE ASKED TO REPLACE IT AT THEIR OWN COST.
- ❖ AS A SPECTATOR AT GAMES AND TOURNAMENTS PARENTS AND STUDENTS ARE ASKED TO:

  - RESPECT THE COACHES, REFEREES AND SCOREKEEPERS.
  - PUT ALL GARBAGE IN THE PROPER RECEPTACLES.
